Please avoid the following:

- Adults conversing with the teacher or other students during instruction. The hours
  of 8:30-12:30 are for student interaction with each other and the teacher. If you
  need to speak to a faculty member please make an appointment via phone or
  email for after school hours.

• Completing the school work for your children. We understand that students may find some lessons more challenging than others, but their work must be a true reflection of their academic ability. Don't be disappointed if it takes some time to master a skill. Please know that teachers are taking note of students' strengths and weaknesses so that they can be addressed appropriately in the classroom. Please be patient and support your child by using encouraging words.

If we all observe these practices it will make the remote experience, however long that may be, much more beneficial for all parties involved.
