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
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FOURTH GRADE NEWS: Ms. Mastellone

Happy New Year! The fourth grade mathematicians' tool belts are expanding. They have diligently been using addition, subtraction, multiplication, and long division to solve multi-step word problems. The key word that has helped us get through these challenging problems is PERSEVERANCE. Perseverance means to show dedication and patience during difficult situations. We have been solving these mathematical problems by constructing arguments, using critical reasoning, creating comparison sentences, and using higher order thinking. In science, the students have been enthusiastically studying weather conditions. We began our research by dissecting Earth's atmosphere. The children discovered the 4 layers and how each layer impacts the surface of our planet. Next, they discussed what an air mass was and that when air masses meet at a FRONT, weather occurs! Lastly, everyone is going to explore the instruments meteorologists use to predict the weather.
