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SECOND GRADE NEWS: Mrs. Spina & Mrs. Dinkjian

As we finish out the school year, we continue to interactively read aloud. Additionally, students are reading independently as well. Research shows that students who read for more than 20 minutes a day increase their reading stamina, vocabulary and comprehension. Our goal has been to read for more than 20 minutes each day. Please continue reading on weekends and over the summer. We have written opinion pieces, personal narratives, and performed independent research for informative writing and projects. Examples of this are the reports your children have written on animals or famous artists. Please ask your child to share them with you as they may be very proud of their efforts. We are reviewing all that we have learned throughout the year in math including adding and subtracting in the hundreds through the use of counters. We've built, drawn, and written about finding answers to problems. We've also learned about cash money, including how to make change or check to see if we receive the correct change. We learned how to tell time on an analog clock, the basics of geometry, and measurement. Have a wonderful summer reading and sharing adventures and conversations with your children.
